- 1. The commission/service charges must be quoted in whole number. Any quotation in decimal, fraction will automatically disqualify the bid/rejected.
- 2. In case of more than one successful lowest bidders (L-1), the work / contract will be awarded to the firm, who have more average turnover in the preceding three financial years (2018-19, 2019-20, 2020-21).

### **Special Terms & Conditions of the contract:**

- 1. The deduction of Income tax (TDS) from the bills of the firm will be made at source as per rate applicable from time to time.
- 2. The online bidding document should be submitted online on GeM within the stipulated date and time.
- 3. The tender documents may also be downloaded from this office website https://nbsslup.icar.gov.in/ (Tender Notice).
- 4. Bidders / bidders are requested to visit the website https://nbsslup.icar.gov.in/and GeM regularly. Any changes/modifications in tender enquiry will be intimated by Corrigendum through this website only.
- 5. In case, any holiday is declared by the Government on the day of opening, the tenders will be opened on the next working day at the same time. The ICA R NBSS & LUP reserves the right to accept or reject any or all the tenders.
- 6. Financial Bid will be opened only of those firms which qualify the technical bid.
- 7. In accordance with O. M. No. 29(1)/2014-PPD dated 28.01.2014 of Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance, bids quoting 'Nil' consideration/service charges shall be treated as unresponsive and will not be considered

# IMPORTANT TERMS & CONDITIONS FOR THE CONTRACT AND SCOPE OF WORK. THESE TERMS & CONDITIONS WILL BE INTEGRAL PART AND PARCEL OF THE AGREEMENT.

- 1. The selected agency shall provide manpower in Office as well as Bhumi Vihar, Residential Complex at ICAR-NBSS&LUP, Regional Centre Kolkata. The agency shall employ good and reliable persons with robust health and clean record antecedent duly verified by the police department preferably within the age group of 18 to 50 years to carry out the service contract. In case, any of the personnel so engaged by the agency is not found suitable, ICAR-NBSS & LUP shall have the right to ask for its replacement without giving any reason thereof and the agency shall receipt of a written communication in this regard, will have to replace such person(s) immediately. If the contractor wants to change personnel deputed at our Centre, the Contractor should communicate our office first in written with proper reason, and then with the consent of Competent Authority the Contractor may change the concerned person/s.
- 2. Technical Evaluation: Before financial evaluation the bids shall be screened for eligibility for technical on the following basis (1) signature on each page of tender documents (2) duly filled in checklist along with the page no. (3) Supporting documents in support of checklist. If any of discrepancy found at this screening stage the bids shall summarily be rejected.
- 3. The manpower services are to be provided as detailed in RFP (Annexure-III). The firm has to provide full detail of the workmen along with their contact numbers for easy access.
- 4. The non compliance of schedule of work in respect of performance to the satisfaction of concerned In-charge/Competent Authority of ICAR-NBSS&LUP, Kolkata may attract the penalty of deduction of payment worked out on pro-rata basis from the monthly charges for the portion of services completed after scheduled time.
- 5. All the manpower deployed by the firm has to present on all the working days.
- 6. The personnel engaged by the agency for this job contract will not be an employee of the ICAR-NBSS & LUP and there will be no employer -employee relationship between the ICAR-NBSS & LUP and the personnel so engaged by the contractor.
- 7. The agency shall be wholly responsible for making payment of monthly salaries and other admissible allowances to the personnel under Minimum Wages Act and Contract Regulation and Abolition Act, 1970 & 1971, the ICAR-NBSS&LUP, Kolkata shall in no way be responsible for meeting any kind of expenditure on salaries etc. to these personnel.
- 8. The Security Money so deposited shall be liable to be forfeited or appropriated in the event of unsatisfactory performance of the Contractor and/or loss/damage, if any, sustained by the Institute on account of the failure or negligence of the workers deployed by him or in the event of breach of the agreement by the Contractor.
- 9. The rates quoted shall include the cost of material, labour, T&P etc, as required for the completion of work.

- 10. The quoted rates shall be inclusive of all taxes, duties, GST etc. as applicable and no extra charges shall be payable on this account.
- 11. TDS as per rules shall be deducted from the bills of the contractor. The agency must enclose copy of PAN No. supported by copy of PAN Card of the company.
- 12. Payment will be released on monthly arrear basis after receiving the bills in triplicate and certification by In-charge/concern authorized person.
- 13. Since there may be delay in releasing payment by ICAR- NBSS&LUP, the Agency due to contingencies payment of wages to the man power by the agency should not be linked with receiving of payment from ICAR-NBSS&LUP and the contractor / agency shall pay the **minimum wage as per Central Government** rate to his staff deployed / engaged at ICAR-NBSS&LUP by 7th of every month by **cheque only**.
- 14. The quotation submitted by the agency should remain valid for period of 90 days from the date of opening of tenders.
- 15. Tenderer shall be responsible for strict compliance of all rules and regulations which is already enforced or which may be enforced from time to time by the appropriate authority.
- 16. The tenderer must visit the site and shall satisfy him as per conditions under which the work is to be performed. He shall also check and ascertain the locations of any existing system or equipment or any other situation, which may affect the work. No extra claim for ignorance of on the ground of insufficient description will be allowed at a later date.
- 17. In case of non satisfactory service, ICAR-NBSS&LUP authority may impose penalty (financial or other) as deemed fit and ICAR-NBSS & LUP decision to this effect shall be final and binding on the contractor.
- 18. The contractor will work in close cooperation and coordination with other agencies working at site.
- 19. ICAR-NBSS&LUP will not provide any mode of transport in respect of men or material required for the contract.
- 20. The contractor shall ensure that either he or his representative is available for proper administration and supervision at the work place.
- 21. In case of any damage or loss to the ICAR-NBSS&LUP property or material directly or indirectly by the contractor's personnel, the contractor shall be held fully responsible, and the ICAR-NBSS&LUP shall be entitled to deduct appropriate amount with penalty from contract fees payable to the contractor. The amount of loss or damage as determined by the NBSS&LUP authority shall be final and binding on the contractor.
- 22. The contractor will be solely and exclusively responsible to adhere all the statutory obligations under Indian law in respect of compliance of all the rules, regulations and directions given by and statutory authority with regard to safe, labour laws or other prevalent laws.

- 23. The contractor shall indemnify at all times and keep indemnified the owner and its officers, servants and agents from and against all third party claims whatsoever including but not limited to property loss and damage, personal accident, injury or death of / or property or person of any sub-contract and or the servants or agents of the contractor any sub-contractor (S) and/or the owner and the contractor shall at his own cost and initiative at all times, maintain all liabilities under Workmen's Compensation Act/Fatal Accident Act, Personal injuries, Insurance Act and/or their Industrial Legislation from time to time in force.
- 24. The Experience certificate/work completion certificate is to be submitted with the tender documents.
- 25. No payment shall be made in advance.
- 26. The Technical Bid should contain Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) of appropriate value as mentioned above in the form of bank Demand Draft/ Banker's cheque in favour of ICAR-NBSS&LUP payable at Kolkata or exemption if any without which the tender shall be summarily rejected. EMD of tendering parties, whose tenders are not accepted, shall be refunded without interest, within 60 days of opening of tenders.
- 27. The EMD is liable to be forfeited if the successful tenderer does not accept the contract within the period of validity of the tender.
- 28. The contractor shall not sublet the contract or any part thereof to any other party.
- 29. The Director, ICAR-NBSS&LUP, Nagpur reserves the right to cancel/terminate the contract at any time during the contract after giving one months notice to the contractor.
- 30. In case of quoted L -1 firm is more than one, then the past performance of the Tenderer will be the sole criteria of selection and it would be at the discretion of ICAR-NBSS&LUP, Kolkata and the decision of Director, ICAR-NBSS & LUP, Nagpur to this effect will be final in all respect and will be binding to all the tenderers.
- 31. Even after qualifying the technical bid, the financial bid may not be accepted if found not in order at the sole discretion of Director, ICAR- NBSS&LUP, Nagpur.
- 32. The Contract is initially valid for ONE YEAR. It can be withheld/ curtailed due to any reasons by either side by giving one month prior notice.
- 33. ICAR-NBSS&LUP, Kolkata reserves the right to accept or reject any or all the tender in part or whole or may cancel without assigning any reason thereof. No correspondence in this regard will be entertained.
- 34. The job of minor shifting of furniture items and other items will also be done by the personnel engaged by the contractor for the referred job as and when required and no extra amount shall be paid by the ICAR-NBSS & LUP to the Contractor for this work.

- 35. Each of the manpower deployed will carry Identity Card issued by the agencies, perform their duty in proper uniforms and will maintain a smart turn-out. The agency shall, at its own cost, provide suitable uniforms to the personnel.
- 36. The personnel provided shall be under the direct control and supervision of the Contractor/Agency. However, the contractor shall comply with the oral and written instructions given on day to day basis, by the officer(s) authorized by the NBSS&LUP from time to time.
- 37. The rates to be quoted shall include cost of each and every item including transportation cost, manpower cost and taxes etc. The ICAR-NBSS&LUP shall not bear any extra charge on any account whatsoever i.e EPF & ESI contribution, OTA etc. Wages to be paid to the contractual manpower will be as per minimum wages act. Contractor will be reimbursed for the work as per the rates detailed in Schedule- II. Bids quoting 'NIL" Service charges/consideration shall be treated as irresponsible and will not be considered.
- 38. Successful firm will have to enter into a detailed contract agreement with NBSS&LUP on non-judicial stamp paper of **Rs.100/- (Rupees One hundred only)** or applicable as per the rule.
- 39. That the number of manpower services will be purely need based. Therefore, the number of Contractor's worker may be increased or decreased as per requirement. The Director, ICAR-NBSS&LUP, Nagpur will be under no obligation to engage any specific number of Contractor's worker during the period of contract.
- 40. The ICAR-NBSS & LUP shall reimburse the amount of GST deposited by the contractor with the appropriate authorities. This reimbursement shall be admissible on production of proof of deposit of the same by the contractor.
- 41. That for any increase in the minimum wage specified by the appropriate government, corresponding percentage increase in the agreed wage or any other payment depending upon such wage will be applicable from the date of such order for increase in minimum wage by government.
- 42. That the contractor shall make payment of wages, etc., to the persons so deployed in the presence of representative of the ICAR-NBSS&LUP, Kolkata and shall on demand furnish copies of wage register etc. to ICAR-NBSS&LUP for having paid all the dues to the persons deployed by him for the work under the contract. This obligation is imposed on the contractor to ensure that he is fulfilling his commitments towards his employees so deployed under various Labour Laws having regards to the duties of ICAR-NBSS&LUP in this respect as per the provisions of Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Act, 1970. The contractor shall comply with or cause to be complied with the Labour regulations from time to time in regard to payment of wages, wage period deductions from wages, recovery of wages not paid and deductions unauthorized made, maintenance of wages book, wage slip, publications of scale of wages, and terms of employment, inspection and submission periodical returns.
- 43. The Contractors taking part in this tender process must be registered with the EPF & ESIC authorities. In support of this a copy of the EPF and ESIC registration Certificate shall be submitted along with the Tender without which the tender/offer will not be considered. It shall be the responsibility of the contractor to deposit the amount of ESI & EPF contributions towards the persons deployed at ICAR-

NBSS&LUP under the contract to the concerned authorities on regular/monthly basis in the local bank authorized for this purpose within the stipulated time as prescribed under the rule.

- 44. As other factors like, ESIC, EPF, GST, Minimum Wages are constant as per Govt. rates, the contract will be finalized on the basis of least Service Charges quoted by the Contractors.
- 45. The Contractor shall remove all workers deployed by him on termination of the contract or on expiry of the contract from the premises of NBSS&LUP and ensure that no such person shall create any disruption/hindrance/problem of any nature in Institute either explicitly or implicitly.
- 46. Police verification of all contractual workers is also mandatory.
- 47. That the contractor shall at his own cost, if required, take necessary insurance cover in respect of the aforesaid services rendered to ICAR-NBS&LUP and shall comply with the statutory provisions of Contract Labour (Regulation & Abolition) Act, 1970, Employees State Insurance Act, Workman's Compensation Act, 1923, Payment of Wages Act, 1936, The Employees Provident Fund (and Miscellaneous Provisions) Act, 1952, Payment of Bonus Act, 1965, the Minimum Wages Act, 1948, Employer's Liability Act, 1938, Employment of Children Act, 1938, Maternity Benefit Act and/or any other Rules/Regulations and/or statutes that may be applicable to them.
- 48. Any compensation for disengagement on account of death, disability of any worker deployed at NBSS&LUP, even if such disability manifests after the termination of the contract shall be contractor's exclusive liability.
- 49. The contractor or workers engaged by him will not be on the pay roll of ICAR-NBSS&LUP/Council and will not be entitled to any benefit as applicable to the employees of ICAR-NBSS&LUP/Council.
- 50. The contractor should have minimum 03 years (three years) experience of performing job contract in reputed Govt./Semi Govt. Undertaking/University/ICAR Institution establishment preferably as per details given in technical bid schedule-I.

## 51. LIQUIDATED DAMAGES CLAUSE:

- (i) An amount of Rs. 500/- (Rupees Five hundred only) will be levied as liquidated damages per day, whenever and wherever it is found that the work is not up to the mark at any point. It will be brought to the notice of the supervisory staff of the firm by ICAR-NBSS&LUP and if no action is taken within one hour liquidated damages clause will be invoked.
- (ii) Any misconduct/misbehavior on the part of the manpower deployed by the agency will not be tolerated and such person(s) will have to be replaced immediately.

# 52. Risk Clause:

ICAR-NBSS&LUP reserves the right to discontinue the job contract at any time, if the work are found unsatisfactory by giving a show-cause notice to be replied within a week and also has the right to award the contract to any other agency at the risk and cost of current agency and excess expenditure incurred on account of this can be recovered from pending bills or by rising a separate claim".

# 53. TERMS OF THE CONTRACT

Initially the terms of the contract will be for ONE YEAR and the contract may be renewed or extended for further period of one year on mutually agreed Terms and Conditions subject to satisfactory services provided by the agency. On the expiry of the contract or on its termination, the NBSS&LUP reserves the right to renew the contract on quarterly/half-yearly/yearly basis on the same terms and conditions that may be mutually agreed upon.

#### 54. MODE OF PAYMENT:

The agency shall submit monthly bills along with copies of GST, ECR, E-Challan for deposition of EPF & ESI contribution for the personnel engaged at the site for the job performed during the preceding month on the first working day. The NBSS&LUP shall make payment by means of RTGS/NEFT (online payment) drawn in favour of the agency, after deducting TDS and Penalty amount if any. Therefore, the firm has to submit full detail of bank along with Bank Account number, TAN number, PAN number, IFSC code of bank branch. However, taxes which are as per the rules of the Govt. of West Bengal/GOI shall be deducted at source from monthly bills of the successful firm. The agency shall make payment to their employee through **cheque only** in the presence of officer nominated by NBSS&LUP, Kolkata. The amount of EPF & ESI deposited by the firm with the concerned statutory authorities w.r.t. manpower engaged for the contracted work shall be reimbursable on monthly basis after production of payment challans by the firm along with certified list of EPF & ESI account nos. of employees deployed for contracted work for whom EPF & ESI deposited under challans submitted for re-imbursement by the firm.

#### 55. TERMINATION OF CONTRACT

This contract can be terminated by giving one month's notice on either side and that any notice required to be served shall be sufficiently served on the parties if delivered to them personally or dispatched at the address herein given under registered post. The NBSS&LUP will not have any responsibility towards this for any damage/loss caused and it cannot be challenged in any court of law.

#### 56. LOSS/DAMAGES CLAUSE

In case of any loss or damage done to the property of the ICAR-NBSS&LUP, Regional Centre, Kolkata by the personnel provided by the agency at the location full damages will be recovered from the Agency and decision of the Competent Authority of ICAR-NBSS&LUP shall be a binding on the agency. Besides, recovering of cost, suitable penalty may also be imposed. In case it is found that the firm repetitively fail to act according to the provisions made herein the contract will be liable to be terminated with imposition of suitable penalty including forfeiture of performance security without any prejudice to other administrative and legal remedies available to the institute in matter.

## 57. SECURITY DEPOSIT

An amount of 3% of total estimated value of work is to be deposited by the selected/successful firm as a performance security deposit through Demand Draft/ Fixed Deposit Receipt (in original) from a Nationalized Bank in favour of ICAR Unit, NBSS&LUP payable at Nagpur or only after receiving the office order from the ICAR-NBSS&LUP, Regional Centre Kolkata. In the event of non-

deposition of the same, the earnest money will be forfeited. Performance Security should remain valid for a period of sixty days beyond the date of completion of all contractual obligations of the supplier including warranty obligations. No interest will be paid on the security money deposited with the NBSS&LUP.

- 59. AMENDMENT TO TENDER DOCUMENTS: At any time prior to the deadline for the submission of tenders, the Employer may, correspond for any reason, whether at his own initiative or in response to a clarification or query raised by a prospective tenderer, modify the tender documents by an amendment. The said amendment in the form of an addendum will be sent to all prospective tenderers who have received the tender documents, to reach them 2 days prior to the deadline for the submission of tenders. This communication will be in writing or by telephone/fax and the same shall be binding upon them and the provisions in such addenda shall take priority over the Invitation to Tender and Tender Documents issued previously. Prospective tenderers should promptly acknowledge receipt thereof by telephone/fax to the Employer. In order to afford prospective tenderers reasonable time for preparing their tenders after taking into account such amendments, the ICAR-NBSS&LUP or the Employer may, at his discretion, extend the deadline for the submission of tenders.
- 60. The contractor is advised to do a complete survey on his own of location and buildings and its surrounding area before offering rates.

In case of any dispute arising, decision of Director, ICAR-NBSS&LUP, Nagpur will be final and binding.
