(A Brief Report on Vigilance awareness week held at the ICAR-NBSS & LUP, Nagpur from 27th October – 2nd November 2025)

ICAR-National Bureau of Soil Survey and Land Use Planning, Nagpur and its five Regional Centres organised Vigilance awareness week programmes from 27th October – 2nd November 2025 with the theme on “Vigilance: Our shared responsibility”. The programme was initiated by taking of the integrity pledge by all the employees of Bureau at HQs Nagpur and its Regional Centers on 27th October, 2025. The Integrity Pledge was administered by Dr Ch. Jyotiprava Dash, Vigilance Officer, ICAR-NBSS&LUP in the presence of Director of the Institute Dr N.G. Patil at the HQs Nagpur, whereas, it was administered by the Head as well as Nodal Officer at the Regional Centres. The pledge reiterated that corruption has been one of the major obstacles to economic, political and social progress of our country, which needs to be strategically tackled and eradicated together by promoting vigilance and commitment to highest standards of honesty and integrity by all stakeholders including Government, citizens and private sector.

During this period display of Banners and Posters on “Vigilance: Our shared responsibility” in Hindi and English were placed in front of main building at Institute, and its regional centres.

Essay competition was held on 28th October 2025 among the staff at HQs Nagpur (*Topic: Promoting Integrity in the workplace: The role of Vigilance in everyday office practices*), and on 29th October 2025 at Regional Centre, New Delhi. A debate on the topic “Is eradication of corruption only Government’s Duty? In Hindi” was organised by NBSS&LUP, RC, New Delhi on 28th October 2025. Similarly a slogan competition was held among the staff of Regional Centres, New Delhi, and Jorhat.

To create awareness among school, and college students, staffs of the Institute including regional centres actively organized various competitions, such as drawing and quiz completions were held. In drawing completion, a total of 21 students from different school of Nagpur, Maharashtra participated, organized by HQs on 29th October 2025. Similarly quiz competition was held among students at College of Agriculture, Udaipur, Rajasthan, conducted by Regional Centre, Udaipur, Rajasthan on 31st October 2025. Further, vigilance awareness programme was conducted by RC, New Delhi and RC Jorhat, in which nearly 200 students participated, and interacted.

Gram Sabha programmes were conducted in Patansawangi village, Ramteck Taluka, Nagpur, Maharashtra on 30th October, 2025 and farmers were sensitized on corruption, fraudity and other issues under VAW-2025. A total of 30 villagers were participated. In Delhi, Gram Sabha programme was organized on 29th October 2025 in the Neelwal village, West Delhi I and farmers were sensitized. The villagers/farmers were encouraged to report any instances of unfair practices or irregularities in agricultural input distribution, procurement, or land-related activities through proper channels. Farmers were made aware of how corruption at any level affects not only productivity but also the socio-economic growth of rural communities. Different media like banners, WhatsApp messages, e-pledge, and Pamphlets were used to disseminate the awareness programme.

Further a lectures was conducted on “Vigilance: Our shared responsibility” (Speaker: Mr. Vineet Jain, (IRPS), Commissioner, Delhi Development Authority (DDA)) on 31st October 2025. He highlighted *“vigilance is not the duty of one department alone, but a collective responsibility of all citizens. Building a transparent and corruption-free nation requires honesty, dedication, and moral courage at every level- from individuals to institutions”*. He also shared his personal experience. Further, Dr. M.S. Raghuvanshi, Principal Scientist, LUP Division, Shri Ashwani Garg (CF&AO, ICAR-NBSS&LUP), Shri Ramdeen (CAO, ICAR-NBSS&LUP) also shared their views and experience on vigilance awareness.

Dr G.P. Obi Reddy, Director-In Charge, ICAR-NBSS&LUP in his remarks emphasized on transparency and integrity in every walk of life, not just during the vigilance week alone so as to help in building organization and trust amongst the stakeholders and the public. At regional centres, talks/lectures also delivered by staffs of the Institute (Speaker: Dr. R.P. Sharma (Principal Scientist, ICAR-NBSS&LUP, Udaipur), K. Sharma (AO, ICAR-NBSS&LUP, New Delhi, Dr. U.S. Saikia (Principal Scientist, ICAR-NBSS&LUP, Jorhat).

Dr Ch. J. Dash Vigilance Officer of the Institute coordinated the vigilance awareness program at HQs with its Regional Centres, which includes the administration of integrity pledge, drawing and essay competition, to bring in far-reaching awareness and impact on the focus of vigilance and integrity. Nodal Officers of all the Regional Centres coordinated and conducted the programme.

The concluding ceremony was marked with prize distribution by the Director In-charge and Head to the staff of the HQs and Regional Centres on various competitions organized during the period. The programme was conducted by its Nodal Officer at HQs as well as Regional Centres and was concluded by the formal vote of thanks.
